





East Jerusalem – Facts and Figures, 2021

75% of Palestinian families in Jerusalem live below the poverty line, compared to 22% of Jewish families



86% of Palestinian children in Jerusalem live below the poverty line, compared to 33% of Jewish children

It is reasonable to assume that these rates increased even more following the coronavirus crisis.


Approximately 30% of Palestinian children in East Jerusalem are not enrolled in educational institutions, or there is not information on the educational institution to which they belong.




There is a shortage of **1,670** classrooms — while only **44** classrooms were built in the 2019-2020 school year.

Only around **15%** of land in East Jerusalem (approximately **8.5%** of the total land in Jerusalem) is designated for residential use by Palestinians. Only **2.6%** of the total land of East Jerusalem is designated for public building and use by the local Palestinian population.



Due to the failures in planning, residents in Jerusalem have almost no possibility to obtain building permits. As a result, much of the construction is undertaken without permits. In recent years, there has been a sharp rise in home demolitions.

Only around **44%** of the residents of East Jerusalem have proper and legal connections to the water grid.

In 2020, the HaGihon water company replaced **4,203.89** meters of sewage lines in East Jerusalem and laid **6,760.86** meters of new lines, but there is still a shortage of around

23,950

meters of sewage lines.
